

MUSINGS

The CMA, Catholic Ministries Appeal, is coming quickly to its end, on June 30. As we're in the middle of April, we have about 10 more weeks to make our goal. Currently, this is how we stand:

Goal:	\$167,986
To Date:	\$138,240
Need:	\$29,746

We have 754 households in the parish that have participated. This is out of 3,200+ households registered. In other words, about 24% of the parish has raised about 82% of our goal. I am very grateful for this and can't thank you enough for your generosity. We are light years from where we were at this time last year.

Let me make this clear: we will have to find this money somehow if we do not make our goal. Either through taking this out of our savings, which I really don't want to do, or to start having special second collections through the months of May and June. Which, again, I really don't want to do. If we can make our goal, that would be fantastic. If we can exceed our goal, the amount over will be split between the diocese and the parish.

This weekend, in our Church vestibules, I'm going to leave CMA envelopes. If you have not contributed, would you consider doing so? Even a contribution of \$25 or \$50 can help us. If you have already given and can give another \$10 or \$20, that would be great.

The CMA helps us in so many ways. It funds the diocesan offices, the bishop's office, and much more. Catholic Charities works tirelessly throughout our diocese helping those in tremendous need. From homeless shelters to soup kitchens to mental health services, Catholic Charities does a lot!

The offices at the Pastoral Center are busy as well - supporting parishes like St. Lawrence Church and schools like St. Lawrence School. On a weekly basis, someone from our parish and/or school is working with someone from the Pastoral Center on something. Our internet network and computer systems are monitored and supported by the diocesan IT department. The Office of Evangelization and Catechesis supports our Faith Formation office and Youth Ministry. Priests' Personnel supports all of the priests who live and work here. The Office of Deacon personnel supports our three deacons. You see what I'm saying. By supporting the CMA, you support St. Lawrence Church.

To make this easier for everyone, I have left CMA envelopes in every pew. Please consider helping us.

Updates

You will notice that around the school playground, we have installed a fence. We have done this for a few reasons, namely the safety of our children. Over the years, there have been numerous acts of vandalism to our playground involving destruction of the equipment, graffiti, urination on the equipment and other things. Many mornings in the summer, we were finding beer bottles, liquor bottles and other things that indicated to us that overnight, people who shouldn't have been at the playground were. And, many children from the neighborhood come over and play on the playground unsupervised. The playground is not a public park funded by tax dollars. So that the children of St. Lawrence School and the Faith Formation program might have an enjoyable and safe playground, we have installed this fence. Soon, we will be erecting signs indicating that the playground and the athletic field are for the use of St. Lawrence School and Church (such as CYO, scouts, Vacation Bible School, etc.)

Lastly, a note about Mass: Too many people are leaving Mass early (right after receiving communion). While this may be necessary occasionally, it should not be the norm. The number of people trying to rush out is distracting, rude, noisy, and doesn't say very much about our community or our faith. I encourage you to stay the extra few moments, receive the final blessing and wait for the priest and deacon to reach the vestibule before exiting. Thank you.


