Deacon Bill Rabjohn

It is my joy to announce to all of you that St. Lawrence Church welcomes Deacon Bill Rabjohn! Bishop Matano has appointed Deacon Bill to serve us. He comes with great experience and I encourage you to read his own introduction below. You will have the chance to get to know him over the next few months. I am grateful for his willingness to serve here, and I know you will be most gracious in your welcome. Here is his introduction to you:

As early as I can remember, my aspiration is to know God. I was born into a Protestant family and prayerfully studied the Bible. This was the path given to me by my parents. The Holy Scriptures are the teachings, the understanding, and the content of knowing God, and yet they often are simply "a finger pointing to the Way". In my late twenties, a budding awareness of the Real Presence of God in the Eucharist led me to become Catholic. The Sacraments offer a tangible experience of the intangible Mystery we call God out of which there was a prompt to become aware of the Real Presence of Christ in each moment, interaction, and service in life or in a formal term, Mysticism. My prayer life moved from "arrows shot into heaven", to the Psalms of joy and sorrow of life, to silence of contemplative prayer, to practicing prayer in each moment. In the silence, the "still small voice" – the wisdom from the heart – arises and there begins an awakening that there is only Christ. Everything else that defines "me" separate from Christ is an illusion – a suffering falsehood. So, I continue on the path to know God. As St. John the Baptist said, "He must become greater; I must become less." (John 3:30). "Becoming less" is the practice of simplicity, which is counterintuitively very joyous and practical as we rest in God.

Along this path I've had the opportunity to play many different roles in life: A husband for thirty-nine years. A father of two adult children. A brother to two siblings. A farm laborer in childhood, a son of a gunsmithing business owner, a mechanical engineer, a project manager, a director of operations for a manufacturing company, a business consultant, a co-founder of a community church, a parish business manager, a fulltime pastoral associate, a pastoral administrator, a facilities manager, a part-time chaplain at a nursing home. A story teller, cook, dishwasher, toilet bowl cleaner, laundry folder, gardener, diaper changer, and a permanent deacon.
