All Souls' Day

Next Sunday is November 2 which is All Souls' Day. The readings and prayers for the all the Masses (Saturday 4 p.m. and Sunday 8 and 10 a.m.) will be for All Souls'. The 10 a.m. Mass Intention will be for all the people enrolled in our St. Lawrence Church Memorial Society, to pray for the repose of their soul.

Please note that since All Saints' Day is on a Saturday this year, it is not a Holy Day of Obligation.

To pray for the repose of the soul of those who have died is part of our Catholic Works of Mercy: to bury the dead. In the Catholic tradition, we just don't bury the body and move on with life. We give thanks for the man or woman or child who was made in God's image, whose body was the temple of the Holy Spirit, whose soul is in the hands of God. It is right and proper that all Catholic Christians have the Mass of Christian Burial upon their death, a funeral Mass. Over the years, confusion over this has caused hurt and added to the pain of grief. I want to help you with this, if I may.

When your loved one dies, the first thing you should do is begin to pray for the repose of their soul. Offer a prayer to God for them. That is a sign of faith and a sign of love. Contact your funeral director. Typically, they will come to collect your loved one. When you speak to the funeral director, let them know when you would like to schedule the Mass of Christian Burial. Give them a range of days, two or three, for the Mass. Please, don't focus on one day or only give the funeral director/church one day for the Mass. That day may not be available for a variety of reasons. The funeral director will contact the church and set the date with us. We typically celebrate funeral Masses at 9:30 a.m. or 10:00 a.m.

Once the date has been set, we will contact you to have you come in for short meeting to go over the Mass. We will discuss the Scripture readings and the hymns that will be at the Mass. (Please, we cannot substitute any other readings for the Scriptures, and we do not allow music that is not from the hymnal, no secular music). You may have individuals proclaim the Scripture readings, as long as they are Roman Catholic. We can also proclaim them for you, if you need.

People often inquire about eulogies. Technically a eulogy (a talk that is biographical and anecdotal) is not allowed a Catholic Mass of Christian Burial. **Words of Remembrance of Faith** may be given. This is a short 2 to 3 minute talk about the deceased's life of faith and how they lived that faith out during their life. Only one person may deliver these words, they must be Catholic, and they are given at the beginning of Mass, after the Entrance Hymn. They must be written out and pre-approved by the Pastor or the Pastoral Associate.

The Church has done most of the preparation for the Mass of Christian Burial for you. This will help at the time of grief which can be so difficult to bear. If you wish to pre-plan the liturgy, please go to our website and find the tab for Funeral Planning. It will all be explained and we'll be happy to hold onto your planning forms. God be with you. And may the souls of the faithful departed rest in peace. Amen.




Thanksgiving Shared Sunday November 1st and 2nd
