Last weekend, I mentioned in the homily that Pope Leo spoke via satellite to the NCYC (the National Catholic Youth Convention). The NCYC is the premier Catholic youth event on a national scale that gathers people from all across America for a life-changing encounter with Christ. Youth and young adults gather for prayer, interaction, and most importantly – for Mass. While I have never been to one of these gatherings, I know from watching events on YouTube and from conversations with people from Rochester who go – it is a powerful and spiritual experience for our young people.

What surprises many older people is that our youth and young adults are more and more expressing a desire for more traditional Catholic prayer, experiences, liturgy, and music. Benediction, Gregorian Chant, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament are what they ask for. When Pope Leo XIV spoke to the convention a couple of weeks ago, there was an overwhelming applause for him. Our young people love our pope and our Catholic Church.

I am beginning to notice, happily, more young people coming to Mass. Young families and single young adults are here. You are most welcome and wanted. Of course, this doesn't mean we want the older people, the Middle-Aged or the Senior Adult. No, of course we want you. We want people of every age, race, language, and background to be with us and to pray as one Catholic community.

More and more, I find it important that we celebrate and honor our Roman Catholic faith, tradition, and heritage. We need to be proud of who we are. I am not saying that we throw out everything that has taken place in last fifty years – it is not either/or. It is both/and.

We can sing both more contemporary Catholic hymns AND sing together in Latin the Gregorian Chant. We must always remember that we are both a Church for today and a Church that is 2,000 years old. And we must, as Pope Leo told our youth, not label our Church in categories that are more suitable for politics. We should identify ourselves for who we are: Roman Catholic Christians.

As one parish, one community united by our Catholic faith to each other, to our bishops, to our Pope – let us spend some time in this Holy Season of Advent to once again give thanks to God for our Catholic Church. There is much to be proud of in our Church. There is much to give God thanks for. And as we, the parish of St. Lawrence move forward in our faith, let us do so proudly as the Catholics we are, proud of our faith!

Please take a stocking or two from the tree on the weekend of December 6th and 7th and shop for the requested item.


