First, let me take a moment in this column to thank all of the people who made our Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Masses so beautiful. On Wednesday, May 14 at 6:30 p.m. at Sacred Heart Cathedral, Bishop Matano will celebrate Mass and the Rite of Confirmation. 56 of our parishioners will be confirmed that night. Please remember them in your prayers.

When you enter the church, I hope you will notice the votive candles that are now placed next to the statues of the Blessed Mother and St. Joseph. These candles are a symbol of the prayers of the faithful and symbolic of our faith. The candles are 8 day candles. If you wish to have one of those candles burn in the memory of a loved one or for a special intention, contact our parish office. Just as we do for the Sanctuary Lamb near the Tabernacle, we will publish your intention in the parish bulletin. The suggested offering for the Tabernacle Sanctuary Lamp is \$20. The suggested offering for the candles near the Blessed Mother and Saint Joseph is \$15. The suggested offering for the 5 days candles at the statue of St. Lawrence is \$10.

You will also notice that the usual Tabernacle is not there right now! Our Tabernacle is older and, with time, it has tarnished and grown dull. We are having the Tabernacle refinished/replated, the satin material on the inside replaced, and the locking mechanism checked and oiled. It will come back to us in a few months, probably July. We will use the smaller Holy Thursday Tabernacle of Reposition until then.

And thank you to our benefactors who are making this possible and who also made possible the new Coronation Tapestry Altar Cloth, statue of our Risen Lord, and pulpit tapestry. May God bless them and all of you!
