It is a very exciting thing to announce we have a new bishop! Pope Leo XIV has accepted Bishop Matano's resignation letter that he submitted 4 years ago. The Canon Law of the Church requires all bishops to submit their resignation when they reach 75 years of age. The resignation does not become official until the pope accepts it.

Pope Leo has appointed Bishop John Bonnici as our 10th Diocesan Bishop. He comes to us from the Archdiocese of New York where he has served since his ordination in 1991. He is 60 years old. He has been an Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese since 2022.

Bishop Bonnici will be installed as our bishop on Thursday, March 19 which is the feast of St. Joseph.

I want to take a moment in this column to express my personal thanks and yours for Bishop Matano. He has led our diocese for 13 years. He works tirelessly and is devoted to our diocese. His humor, compassion, and care for all the people of the diocese has always been evident. It is with gratitude that we wish him many blessings as he enters this new phase of his life.

And so, in 8 months, we have a new pope and a new bishop! There is an old saying that God provides for us and gives us the pope and bishop we need for the moment. It seems this is true.

Let us pray for both men as they work to guide us on our pilgrim way of faith. And may the Lord watch over all of us always!
